Students are responsible for their missing work. Students will have the equivalent numbers of days that they were absent to submit their missed work. Please, see Student Handbook for more details.

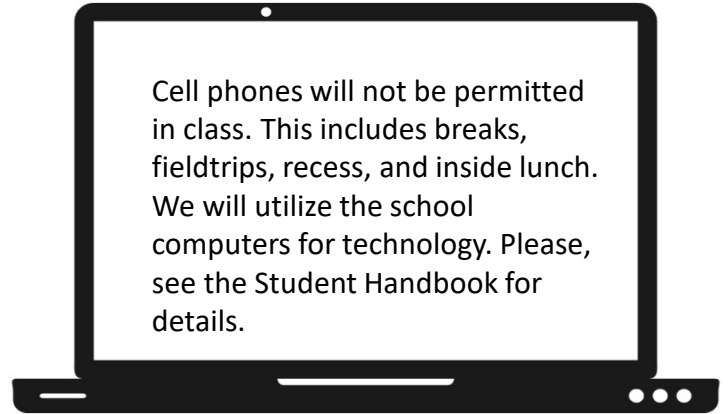
## FOOD & DRINK
